Curriculum: Our Global & Balanced Approach

Early Years Curriculum

At AISB, we use the Australian Early Years Learning Framework 'Belonging, Being and Becoming' as our guiding curriculum. To support our students in the development of their social – emotional skills, we offer a wellbeing health program to our young learners called Kimochis. The Kimochis program was designed to give children the knowledge, skills, and attitudes they need to recognise and manage their emotions, demonstrate caring and concern for others, establish positive relationships, make responsible decisions, and handle challenging situations constructively.

Primary Curriculum

Our school follows the Australian Curriculum to develop confident, creative individuals and informed global citizens, equipping learners with essential life skills. Through an enquiry-based approach, students engage in authentic, rigorous learning that prepares them with 21st-century skills. Core subjects—English, Mathematics, Science, Humanities, Social Sciences, and Health—are taught by homeroom teachers, alongside specialist classes like chess, swimming, Thai, languages, art, music, and sports. In 2023/24, we introduced the Initialit Reading Program in Years F–Y2, a modern, well-researched program from Australia that accelerates literacy skills for primary students.

Secondary Curriculum

(Australian Lower Secondary / IGCSE / Advanced Levels)

The Australian Year 7/8 curriculum offers a world-class education, focusing on English, Mathematics, Science, and Humanities (History, Geography, Global Studies). It includes adjustments to align with the Lower Cambridge curriculum, preparing students for the IGCSE in Year 9. The IGCSE, a two-year program with core and elective subjects, concludes with exams in Year 10 and is widely recognised for academic progression. In Years 11 and 12, students complete Cambridge AS Levels (Year 11) and A Levels (Year 12), which are globally respected by top universities and future employers.



Pathways to Success: IGCSE & A-Levels at AISB

The Cambridge International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE) is the world's most popular international qualification for 14 to 16 year olds. It attracts almost 500,000 entries from 144 different countries every year. The IGCSE is designed to be taught as a two-year course beginning in Year 9 and culminating in external examinations in Year 10.

After IGCSE, students can progress to the **AS and A-Level programs**, starting with AS Level in Year 11 and advancing to A-Level in Year 12. These programs provide opportunities to specialise in chosen subjects, develop critical thinking and independent learning skills, and prepare for university and future careers.

The IGCSE and A-Level programs at AISB offer a rigorous academic foundation, preparing students for higher education and future careers. Through a diverse range of subjects, students develop critical thinking, problem-solving, and independent study skills. The examinations assess their understanding and application of knowledge, providing a globally recognised qualification that opens doors to universities and professional opportunities worldwide.

University Foundation Year

We offer an extra year for those students who need additional time to complete their A Levels. Students will also be provided with support to satisfy English proficiency requirements as well as support in completing IELTS and SAT preparation courses.
