

Why Us?

Early Years Curriculum

At AISB, we use the **Australian Early Years Learning Framework** 'Belonging, Being and Becoming' as our guiding curriculum. It has a specific emphasis on play-based learning and recognises the importance of communication and language (including early literacy and numeracy), along with social & emotional development as key focus areas. Our curriculum also draws on the principles of Teaching for Understanding developed at Harvard University Graduate School of Education, and on concepts of inquiry-based learning, providing a structured learning framework for students.

Primary Curriculum

Our school uses the **Australian Curriculum** as the basis for its teaching and learning which is designed to develop confident and creative individuals who will become active and informed citizens. Our enquirybased pedagogical approach ensures intellectual rigour through active and authentic learning which develops deep understandings and prepares students with 21st century skills. The core subjects of English, Mathematics, Science, Humanities and Social Sciences and Health are taught by homeroom teachers in addition to a variety of specialist classes such as chess, swimming, Thai, languages, visual art, media art, music and sports.

Secondary Curriculum

The Australian Year 7/8 curriculum is a world-class curriculum that develops skills and understanding across a broad range of subjects. There are some modification of content to reflect the Lower Cambridge curriculum to ensure students are prepared for entry onto the IGCSE at Year 9. Students in Year 9 and 10 undertake a two year course of study as part of the internationally renowned IGSCE program that consists of a range of core and elective subjects suited to the learner. Our students in Years 11 and 12 complete the Cambridge International Advanced Subsidiary Levels (AS Levels/Year 11) and Cambridge International Advanced Levels (A Levels/Year 12). These examinations are recognised by leading universities and employers worldwide as evidence of academic ability, allowing progression to university.

Our Campuses & Facilities

Our founding campus on **Sukhumvit Soi 20** caters for students from Nursery to Year 1 and is nestled conveniently among the high-rise apartments and residential area of Sukhumvit.

Our **Sukhumvit Soi 31** campus is home to students from Year 1 to Year 12 and is equipped with modern classrooms, purpose-built facilities, science laboratories and green space for our students. Primary and Secondary students have separate campuses with spaces to interact with their peers in a safe environment.

Co-located on our Soi 31 campus is the **AISB Innovation and Sports Centre** which includes our swimming pool, sports field, robotics laboratory, media art rooms and food technology kitchen. Our Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Mathematics (**STEAM**) program is infused across all aspects of our curriculum, with formal classes held at the Innovation Centre.
