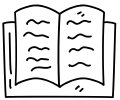

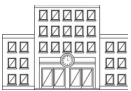

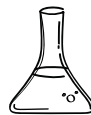

# Curriculum: Our Global & Balanced Approach

## Early Years Curriculum

At AISB, we use the Australian Early Years Learning Framework 'Belonging, Being and Becoming' as our guiding curriculum. To support our students in the development of their social - emotional skills, we offer a wellbeing health program to our young learners called Kimochis. The Kimochis program was designed to give children the knowledge, skills, and attitudes they need to recognise and manage their emotions, demonstrate caring and concern for others, establish positive relationships, make responsible decisions, and handle challenging situations constructively.

## Primary Curriculum

Our school uses the Australian Curriculum as the basis for its teaching and learning which is designed to develop confident and creative individuals who will become active and informed global citizens, equipping each learner with critical life skills for the future.

Our enquiry-based pedagogical approach ensures intellectual rigour through active and authentic learning which develops deep understandings and prepares students with 21st century skills. The core subjects of English, Mathematics, Science, Humanities and Social Sciences and Health are taught by homeroom teachers in addition to a variety of specialist classes such as chess, swimming, Thai, languages, visual art, media art, music and sports. In 2023/24 we commenced using the Initial Lit Reading Program in Yr F-2 to teach Reading. It is a modern, well researched program from Australia that is producing excellent results in Australia.

## Secondary Curriculum (Australian Lower Secondary / IGCSE / Advanced Levels)

The Australian Year 7/8 curriculum is a world-class curriculum that develops skills and understanding in a broad range of subjects, which puts an emphasis on; English, Mathematics, Science and the Humanities (History, Geography, Global Studies).

There is some modification of content to reflect the Lower Cambridge curriculum to ensure students are prepared for entry onto the IGCSE at Year 9. The Cambridge IGCSE programme consists of a range of core and elective subjects suited to the learner, and is a two year course of study, culminating with external examinations in Year 10. The IGCSE is an internationally renowned passport to progression and success.

Our students in Years 11 and 12 will complete the Cambridge International Advanced Subsidiary Levels (AS Levels/Year 11) and Cambridge International Advanced Levels (A Levels/Year 12). These examinations are recognised by leading universities and employers worldwide as evidence of academic ability, allowing progression to university.
