#### **Additional Charges:**

For payment by local credit card, there is an additional charge of 2% and for overseas credit card 3.5% (covered by parents). All bank charges or bank administration fees are covered by parents.

# **School Payment Policies**

#### **Annual Payment Discount**

Advance payment of one complete year's tuition fees will be entitled to a 5% discount on the tuition fee.

### **Sibling Discount**

Sibling Discounts will be applied to the school fee after any annual payment discounts have been deducted.

#### **Penalty for Overdue Payment**

Payment must be made by the due date as stated on the invoice. Overdue payment will incur a late penalty of 3% per month of the outstanding balance after the due date.

In the event that Fees are not paid in full (received as cleared funds by the School) by the due date for payment, the School may also, by notice in writing to the Parents, set a new date for payment of such Fees (or outstanding balance). Failure to complete payment by such date: the student will be deemed to have been withdrawn from School and also may result in the School taking legal action.

#### **Receipts of Payments**

Receipts of payments will be issued specifying the description of the fees and the actual amount received by the school only.

#### **Enrolment Conditions**

Term tuition fees must be paid two weeks before the first day of the term. Students may not be allowed to start school until full tuition payment has been made.

#### **Late Admission**

Tuition fees will be prorated according to the number of remaining days for students commencing school when the start day is more than 16 school days after the term starts. Full term tuition fees will be charged for a student who enrolls within 15 school days after the term starts.

#### **Payment for After School Activities**

There will be no confirmed admission to an Afternoon Activity course until full payment is received. Registrations will only be confirmed when full payment for the course is paid. There is no refund or credit for after school activities cancelled by parents.

#### Student Insurance

AISB maintains limited student accident insurance coverage for activities authorized by and under the supervision of school authorities, and is limited to THB10,000 per accident per student. Parents are required to obtain their own adequate medical insurance for each child. On overseas and overnight trips, travel insurance is mandatory and will be included in the trip cost for all students.

#### **Annual Fee Review**

AISB reserves the right to set the fee structure each year, with reductions applicable to tuition fees only. Fees are set to increase by approximately 5% to 7% per academic year.

## **Refund Policy and Notification of Withdrawal**

Refunds apply to tuition fees only and will be provided if a 15 days advanced written notice of withdrawal is given to the school. Notice should be given to the admissions manager on your campus.

If a student withdraws before the end of a term, there is <u>no refund</u> for the following services already paid for that term:

- AISB school bus service
- lunch fees
- after school activities
- other school fees
- EAL Fees

## **Notification Timing and Refund Amount**

15 calendar days or less before commencement of Term	80% of tuition fee paid for Term
1 to 15 calendar days after Term commencement	50% of tuition fee only paid for Term
16 to 29 calendar days after Term commencement	25% of tuition fee only paid for Term
30 calendar days or more after Term commencement	No refund

#### Notes:

- 1. Tuition and other fees paid for subsequent Terms will be refunded in full.
- 2. The Education Resources Fee will not be refunded after the school year commences.

Refunds will **not** be given for school lunches should a student be absent or on a school trip. The lunch fee is a term-based fee, not a daily fee.

EAL and Learning Support fees are term based with a minimum number of sessions specified at the start of the term. Make up classes will be provided if the school cancels the class and the term minimum is not met.

# **Advance Payment Policy and Refund Conditions**

For families that choose to pay the full year's tuition fee in advance, the following conditions apply if the family decides to leave before the completion of the term:

- If the written notice of withdrawal is given 15 days or more before leaving, the refund for the remaining term will follow the refund schedule outlined above (tuition fees only).
- 2. No refund will be provided for the following services already paid for:
  - Lunch fees
  - After-school activities
  - School bus service
- A full refund will be offered for the next upcoming term if the family has paid in advance and decides to withdraw.

**Important Note:** If the student withdraws before completing the full academic year, the tuition fee will be recalculated based on the standard termly rates without the 5% full-year payment discount. Any applicable refund will then be based on this adjusted fee.

## Part Time Student Policy (Nursery, PreK and Kindergarten)

Parents will confirm the attendance days in the week during admission. Increasing days of attendance during the term is applicable if space is available. If a child is absent, there will be no make-up days permitted. Adding an extra day in the week will incur extra cost for that day.

Part time students will be accepted in special circumstances, and considered on a case by case basis.
