



Australian International School of Bangkok - Return to School Agreement

For any student returning to school, the following document must be agreed to.

I have read this agreement with my family which outlines the school's expectations and rules for returning to on-site learning during the current COVID-19 pandemic. By submitting this form, both parents and students agree to follow the following rules.

I will register on the Thai Save Thai website and complete a Travel and Health Form.

I understand that I must tell my parents if I feel unwell, I must not come to school with a temperature over 37.5C or if I am experiencing any symptoms of COVID-19.

Before school

The night before

- Complete the Thai Save Thai assessment each evening and only go to school the next day if my risk is Low or below.
- Complete my ATK test on a Sunday evening and a Wednesday evening and submit the results and photo immediately each time using my **Year Level ATK Link**.

In the morning

- Check my temperature. If it is over 37.5 I will remain at home.
- Check I have a spare facemask in my bag.
- Check I have my water bottle and spoon and fork.
- Check I have my own hand sanitizer (if I want it with me)
- Wear a facemask on the way to school.

Travel to school

- I will travel with the same people every day if possible and go straight to school.
- If I use public transport I will ensure I follow appropriate COVID-19 precautions.
- I will wear my mask in the car/bus/van.
- I will ensure I have my bags and uniform ready so I can exit the car or van as quickly and safely as possible.

Arrival at School

- Have temperature taken by the temperature scanner.
- If I have a temperature over 37.5 degrees Celsius I will return home.
- Go straight to my classroom after the temperature check.

In School

- Keep my mask on all-day apart from eating, drinking or when instructed to remove it by my teacher.
- Sit only in my allocated seat within the classrooms.
- Inform the teacher if I feel unwell.
- Wash my hands after going to the toilet and write my name on the Toilet Chart. My class Teaching Assistant will write it for me if I am in Year 1 or below.
- Wash my hands with alcohol gel or soap and water before snack, lunch and before entering a classroom.
- Keep socially distanced from my classmates and other student wherever possible.
- Use disposable tissues to sneeze or cough into and dispose of in the class bin.
- Follow instructions about how to move around the school and remain COVID-19 safe.

After School

- I will not attend any after school tutoring centres.
- I will use the Mor-Chana/Thai-Chana app to track and trace possible infections outside of school.

COVID-19 Exposure

- If my ATK is positive, I will do a second test. If that test is positive, I will contact the school immediately to inform them and then go and have an RT- PCR test.
- If the RT-PCR test is negative, I will quarantine for 3 days and then return on the 4th day if my ATK is negative.
- If the RT-PCR is positive I will follow medical guidelines and quarantine for at least 14 days. I will only return to school if I have a negative RT-PCR result after 14 days.
- If I am told to quarantine by the school because I or somebody in my class has been exposed to Covid 19, I will follow the school requirements and attend school online.

ATK and TST are dependent on the current COVID-19 zoning of Bangkok, any changes to the regulations will be automatically reflected in this agreement and will not require further acknowledgement.
